The information below is intended to revise, amend, or replace the specified sections of the Project Manual dated March-2018 for the above referenced project. All other information and/or specifications are to remain unchanged for this project unless indicated otherwise.

PROJECT MANUAL

SECTION A:

- 1) Bid Proposal - Page A-14;
 - a. Items 4) and Item 5) – Shall be PVC SDR26 pipe rather than PVC SDR35.
 - b. Item 10) Outside Drop Pipe Assembly, the quantity shall be two (2). Also, this assembly may be precast integral to the applicable manhole supplied.
 - c. Item 13) the 4" x 8" PVC Wye shall be SDR26 or SDR35 as applicable to the sewer main pipe being joined by the wye.

See the attached pages (ATTACHMENT A) which shall replace pages A-12 through A-17, complete. The attached shall be used in the preparation and submittal of bids.

- 2) Engineer's Estimate – The revised Engineer's Estimate of Construction Cost is \$110,000. The lowest responsive and responsible bid must be no greater than 10.0% of this figure for a contract to be awarded.

- B. Bidder has visited the Site and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and is satisfied as to all Federal, State, and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions in or relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at or contiguous to the Site (except Underground Facilities) which have been identified in paragraph 5.03 of the Modified General Conditions, and (2) reports and drawings of a Hazard Environmental Condition, if any, which has been identified in paragraph 5.06 of the Modified General Conditions, as applicable.
- E. Bidder has obtained and carefully studied (or assumes responsibility for having done so) all additional or supplementary examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, and data concerning conditions (surface, subsurface and Underground Facilities) at or contiguous to the Site which may affect cost, progress, or performance of the Work or which relate to any aspect of the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by the Bidder, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bidding Documents to be employed by Bidder, and safety precautions and programs incident thereto.
- F. Bidder does not consider that any further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price(s) bid and within the times and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of the Work to be performed by OWNER and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
 - H. Bidder has correlated the information known to Bidder, information and observations obtained from visits to the Site, reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, and all additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, and data with the Bidding Documents.
 - I. Bidder has given ENGINEER written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and the written resolution thereof by ENGINEER is acceptable to Bidder.
 - J. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance of the Work for which this Bid is submitted.
