

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids will be received by the Village of Waverly, Mayor's Office, 201 W. North Street, Waverly, Ohio 45690 until: **10:00 AM Local Time on December 31, 2018** opened and read aloud immediately thereafter for the necessary services for the "**Village of Waverly, State Route 335 Sanitary Sewer Extension**" project. Bids received after the scheduled closing times for the receipt of bids will be returned unopened to the bidder. Bids are to be sealed and addressed to the Attention of Greg Kempton, Mayor – Village of Waverly, 201 W. North Street, Waverly, Ohio 45690. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the Bid Documents must be enclosed in another envelope addressed as above. Bidders shall state on the outside of the Bid envelope, "**BID PROPOSAL FOR SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS**".

The successful bidder shall supply all materials, equipment, and labor required for project execution as described in the contract documents and as shown on the construction plans.

All Bids shall be made in conformity with the project documents and shall be on the forms bound in the Project Manual and prepared as outlined in the Project Manual. All bids must comply with Instructions to Bidders to be considered.

All Bids shall be made in conformity with the plans and specifications and shall be on the forms bound in the specifications and prepared as outlined in the contract documents. All bids must comply with Instructions to Bidders to be considered.

Each Bid shall be accompanied by a BID GUARANTY AND CONTRACT BOND as required by Section 153.571 of the Ohio Revised Code in an amount equal to the sum of the proposal, supported by a Power of Attorney for the bonding agent, a Certificate from the Department of Insurance authorizing the Surety Company to do Surety business in the State of Ohio, and a current financial statement of the Surety Company. Submittal of a Bid Bond in the amount of 10% of the bid amount is acceptable.

In lieu of posting the Bond, a Contractor may use a Cashier's Check, Certified Check or Letter of Credit for 10% of the Bid as Bid Security. When a check or Letter of Credit is used, the Contractor will be required to post a 100% Performance Bond and a 100% Labor and Material Payment Bond, upon signing of the contract.

Contractors and Subcontractors for this project shall at all times comply with all requirements of the Ohio Civil Rights Act, and shall, if requested by governing bodies, supply all reports or other information requested by them. Also note that State of Ohio prevailing wage rates are required for this project.
